The City of Richmond, Texas has received a petition for inclusion of City of Richmond extraterritorial jurisdiction (ETJ) to an approximate 13.97 acre tract of land presently located within the City of Rosenberg's ETJ. The subject property can be described as:

An approximate 13.97 acre tract of land in the William Andrews League, Abstract No. 3, Fort Bend County, Texas; said 13.97 acre tract being a portion of the remainder of a 24.6723 acre tract of land conveyed to Mark W. Millis, as recorded in Fort Bend County Clerk's File No. 2008081464, and a portion of a 5.5532 acre tract of land "Levee Tract No. 3" conveyed to Fort Bend County Levee Improvement District No. 20, as recorded in Fort Bend County Clerk's File No. 2011056371.
