NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS, THAT:

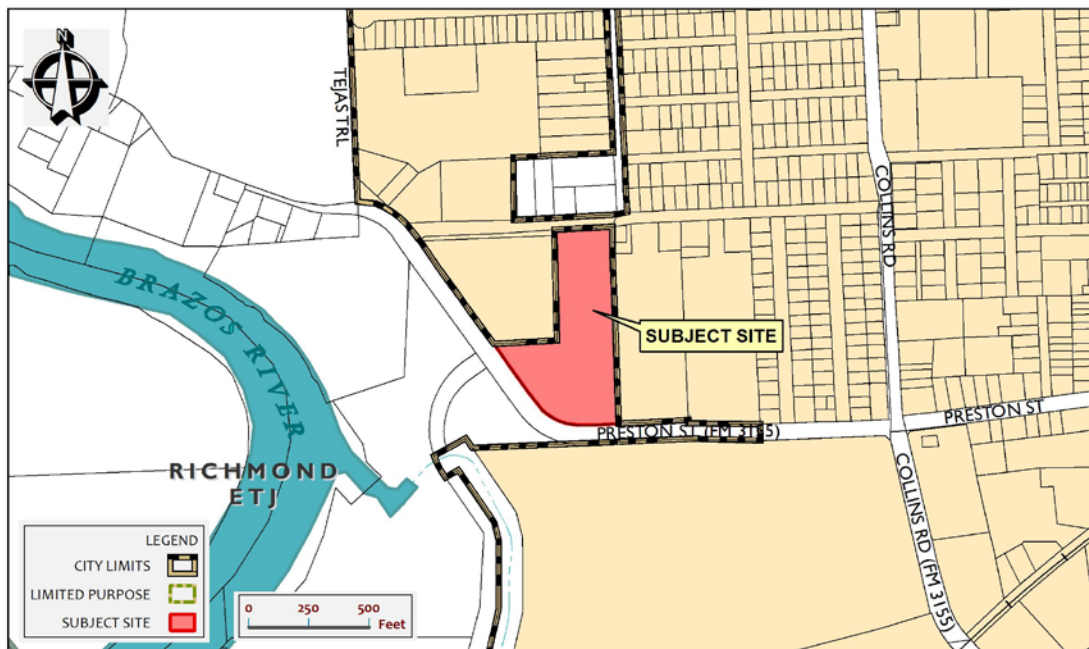
The City of Richmond, Texas has received a petition to annex an approximate 6.567 acre tract of land into the city limits. Therefore, the City proposes to institute annexation proceedings to enlarge and extend the boundary limits of said city to include the following described territory, to-wit:

A tract or parcel containing an approximate 6.567 acres of land situated in the J.T. Edwards Survey, Abstract No. 23, Fort Bend County, Texas, being part of and out of a tract of land conveyed to George Foundation, as recorded under Volume 107, Pg. 526 of the Fort Bend County Deed Records (F.B.C.D.R.). The subject site is located at 2000 Preston Street. The subject property is abutting single family residential uses to the north; old WKM Foundry site to the south; Richmond Trailer Village to the east; and the Riverwood residential subdivision entrance to the west.

A public hearing will be held by and before the City Commission of the City of Richmond, Texas on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2019 at 4:30 p.m. in the City Commission Chamber of the City Hall Annex located at 600 Morton Street, Richmond, Texas, for all persons interested in the above proposed annexation. At said time and place, all such persons shall have the right to appear and be heard. Of all said matters and things, all persons interested in the things and matters herein mentioned, will take notice.
