

Motor Court Design

- The motor court neighborhood design provides detached singlefamily homes, with two car garages, ample driveways, and private yards for all homes at residential densities closer to multi-family developments
- This design provides the most preferred home type – a detached single-family residence – plus the ability to add amenities and greenspace to the neighborhood while also keeping rents reasonably affordable for residents
- The motor court also provides a safe and peaceful place for neighbors to meet and children to play
