Agenda item A1. Call to Order, Quorum Determined and Meeting Declared Open.

Mayor Haas called the meeting to order at 4:33 p.m.

**Agenda item A4.** Discuss and accept the Truth in Taxation Worksheets that coordinate with the FY2023 Certified Tax Roll.

- Finance Director Preza presented the Truth in Taxation Worksheet. As part of the annual
  property tax procedure the Truth in Taxation Worksheet is finalized after the completion
  of the Certified Roll by the Fort Bend County Tax Assessor. The finance team
  independently finalized the Truth in Taxation Worksheet and collaborated with the Tax
  Assessor to arrive at identical tax rates.
- Commissioner Gaul moved to accept the Truth in Taxation Worksheets. Commissioner Beard seconded. Motion passes unanimously.

**Agenda item A5.** Review and discuss FY 2023-24 Annual Budget Workshop to discuss Tax Rate and amendments to the Development Corporation of Richmond.

 The FY24 Proposed Budget was presented, and Finance Director Preza discussed the specifics of the presentation. Staff recommends no change in the tax rate. The proposed

- rate is 0.66000, which is the current rate. The City Commission's members gave feedback so that staff could present a budget at the next meeting.
- Additional discussion on FTE for the Economic Development Coordinator position. The General Fund would receive a transfer of funds from the DCR to cover the cost of the position if the City Commission approved the budget amendment.

## Agenda item A6. Review and record vote on notice to publish tax rate.
