Richmond Historical Commission Meeting Minutes

The Richmond Historical Commission met in a regular meeting on Tuesday, October 18, 2022, at 8:02 a.m. Chairperson Edwards, called the meeting to order. A quorum was present, with the following members in attendance:

Chairperson Edwards declared the meeting open.
