Park Board Recommendations for FY 2017-2018

Below are the City of Richmond Parks & Recreation Board's recommendations for major park projects and improvements for fiscal year 2017-2018.

- 1. Restroom replacement at George Park. The existing restroom needs replacement. The new restroom replacement will reduce routine maintenance and repair costs.
- 2. New park, North Richmond. Funding for preliminary surveys and research. Work on developing the necessary partnerships. Identify the outline of the park and possibly obtain an initial action plan, including Grant funding options. The goal is to start on-the-ground work in 2018-2019.
- 3. Obtain an initial action plan for implementing the Trail Master Plan in the Historic District with primary consideration to Morton Street 200 thru 400 blocks and several connectivity points to Wessendorff Park, the new pavilion, and across Jackson Street at 4th Street to the Travis Building & Old Courthouse.
- 4. George Park Entrance Upgrade.
- 5. George Park Spray Ground Design.
- 6. Budget adjustments to provide adequate maintenance of the Parks. One of the key areas identified through citizen input and surveys was park maintenance. The Board acknowledges that the City has thus far done an excellent job in providing adequate maintenance and upkeep. However, the dynamics of new park additions, capital improvements, and the complexity of the improvements will require additional resources to properly protect our investments. The Board therefore supports recommendations for maintenance budget increases as deemed necessary to preserve our Parks.

The size of the letters as noted in the attached proof: 3" lower case and 4" upper case Size of the boulder as noted in the attached proof: 60"x36"x6"

The cost of your custom boulder:

- one sided boulder as per the proof attached: \$1,839
- double sided boulder as per proof attached: \$ 2,227

This cost includes: design, manufacture, paint, seal, deliver to the park location in Richmond. We have a trailer that we can use, with the only restriction that we need space to back into the sign placement area.


We would like to know if you are planning to have a pedestal built or do you want the boulder to be placed on the ground. We have not included a base/pedestal in our cost.
